

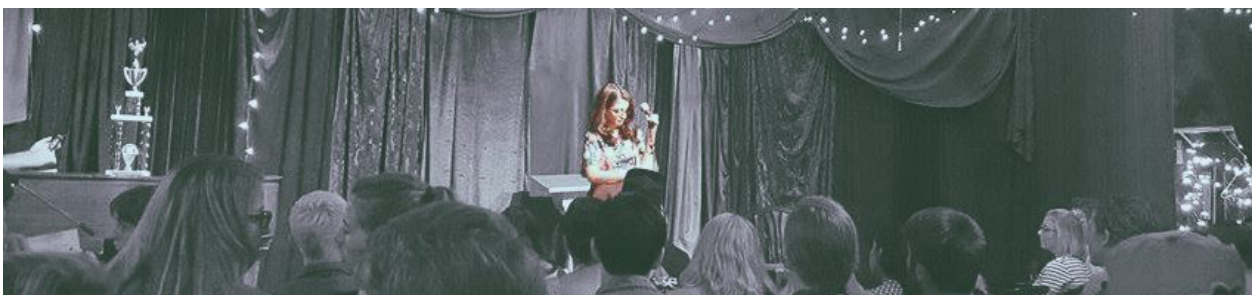

## ★ CARE Support Starts Here Training

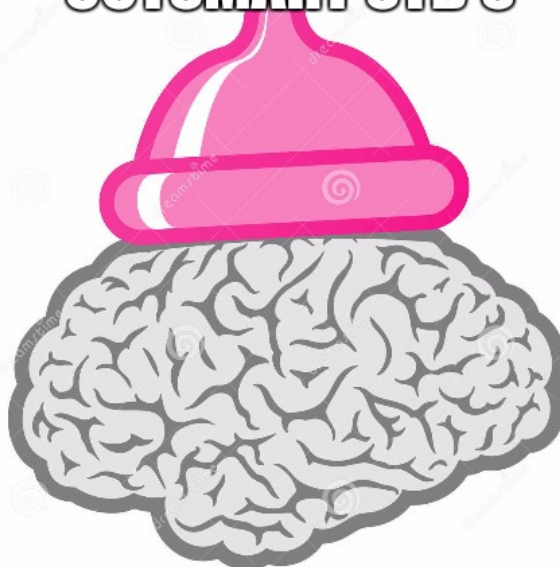
